Description of work	The EWG should: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To determine if the <i>Guidelines on Performance Criteria for Methods of Analysis for the Determination of Pesticide Residues in Food and Feed</i> (CXG 90-2017) adequately cover mass spectrometry and if so, to propose revocation of the <i>Guidelines on the use of mass spectrometry for the identification, confirmation and quantitative determination of residues</i> (CXG 56-2005).• If there are provisions from CXG 56-2005 that could be relevant but not included in CXG 90-2017, to look into the feasibility to merge the two documents, and<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ if appropriate to present a proposal for new work, and○ if possible to present an outline of the merged guidelines for consideration at CCPR52
